



## DUTSCHKE “THE MUSCAT”

(Bottled May 2007)

Back in 1997 (10 years ago already) while working at Baileys in North East Victoria I fell in love with the local rich luscious fortified Muscats. I thought one day it'd be great to produce one for myself. Well this is it!

“The Muscat” is a blend of North East Victorian Muscat which I have “trickled” our own Barossa Muscat and now some of our neighbour, Wally Krieg’s red Muscat into over the recent years. This Muscat shows richness and a complexity of flavours. Fruitcake, toffee, raisins, coffee, combining with the natural grape sweetness, oak and alcohol produce a wine style uniquely Australian.

<b>Cases bottled:</b> Hogsheads only	229 x 6-packs (375ml bottles) 2 x
<b>Vineyard:</b>	Ken Semmler’s and Wally Krieg’s Lyndoch vineyards, the balance from N.E. Victoria.
<b>Region:</b>	North East Victoria and Lyndoch, Barossa Valley
<b>Varieties:</b>	100% Muscat.
<b>Alcohol:</b>	18.0%
<b>Oak Maturation:</b>	Aged in large oak Vats (1,000 litre) and Hogsheads (300 litre).
<b>Cellaring potential:</b>	Best consumed within 18 months of bottling.
